# Rules

## C&H Sugar Company SugArt® Competition



### How to Enter:

1. Complete an entry form. Visit [www.chsugar.com/sugart](http://www.chsugar.com/sugart) and download an official entry form. Or submit an official entry form supplied to schools.
2. Children attending schools, grades K-6th, are eligible to prepare a SugArt project using C&H Sugar Cubes. Project may also use other visual elements such as paint, stickers, glitter, toys, candy, etc. Project can be made for any class or any subject, and is not restricted to art classes.
3. Parent or teacher should take two color photographs with a 35 millimeter, automatic, disposable or digital camera: The first photograph should show the SugArt project with a package of C&H Sugar Cubes. The second photograph should show the child with their SugArt project and a package of C&H Sugar Cubes. Both photos should be at least 4" x 6" in size.

On the back of the photo, hand print parent or teacher's name, child's name, school's name, address, and parent and teacher's telephone number. Only photographs showing the SugArt project with a package of C&H Sugar Cubes will be used for contest judging. Photos should be as clear as possible to ensure best judging opportunity and for use by the media.

The two photographs must be submitted by a parent, teacher, or school official on behalf of a child attending a school in Northern California. Individual child entries only, please.

5. Parent or teacher should mail official entry form and two photos to: C&H SugArt Contest, c/o Torme Lauricella Public Relations, 847 Sansome Street, San Francisco, CA 94111.

### Entry Rules:

1. Entries must be received by April 30, 2005. Only one entry per child. Individual entries only, please.
2. Contest is open to children attending schools, grades K-6th. Parent or teacher signature is required on official entry form.
3. C&H Sugar Company, Inc. is not responsible for lost, misrouted or delayed entries or photos.
4. Employees of C&H Sugar Company, Inc., Torme Lauricella Public Relations, their families and any of their affiliates, agencies, contactors, vendors or service providers are ineligible to participate.
5. Void where prohibited by law. Sponsored by the C&H Sugar Company, Inc.

### Judging:

1. The panel of judges will be comprised of an elementary school teacher, a middle school teacher, a commercial artist, a representative from Torme Lauricella Public Relations and a representative from the C&H Sugar Company, Inc.
2. SugArt sculptures will be judged on originality of concept, quality of execution and aesthetic appeal, as appropriate to grade level. A selection of the best projects from each age group will be assembled. Best Overall and a Second Best Overall prize winners will then be determined based on which projects best demonstrate creative expression. A prize for Most Original Entry will also be awarded to the student who constructs the most imaginative, unique SugArt sculpture.
3. Judging will be completed by May 14, 2005. Winners will be notified by phone or mail.

### Prizes:

1. One (1) Grand Prize Winner: Best Overall – Student will receive a \$1,000 U.S. EE Savings Bond. The teacher of the grand-prize winning student will receive a \$500 check payable to the school for art supplies.
2. One (1) Grand Prize Winner: Most Original Entry – The Most Original category rewards the student who creates the most unique, creative SugArt entry. Student will receive a \$1,000 U.S. EE Savings Bond. The teacher of the grand-prize winning student will receive \$500 to be paid to the school for school art supplies.
3. One (1) Second Prize Winner: Best Overall – Student will receive a \$500 U.S. EE Savings Bond. The teacher of the second-prize winning student will receive \$250 to be paid to the school for school art supplies.
4. As a condition of receiving their prizes, winners' parent/guardian must sign an affidavit of eligibility, liability release and publicity release allowing the C&H Sugar Company, Inc. to use the winners' name, likeness and SugArt photograph on website, and other promotional materials.
5. All photographs become property of C&H Sugar Company, Inc.
